Connecting Ukrainians to Employment (CUE) Program

EMCN's CUE Program:

- Began in Oct. 2022 and will run until Sept. 2024.
- Provides FREE employment services to Ukrainian evacuees (newcomers) impacted by the ongoing war in Ukraine.
- Purpose is to build employability skills and transition
 Ukrainian newcomers into the Canadian workforce and achieve financial independence.
- Offers services in English and Ukrainian, and connects with participants in-person, over the phone and virtually.

Participants:

- Explore career and employment options with EMCN staff and work collaboratively to achieve goals.
- Receive pre-employment and safety training to improve their job search knowledge (i.e. resume, cover letter, interview skills, etc.)
- Receive ongoing support after employment.
- Gain access to employment and networking opportunities.

How the CUE Program Works

- EMCN CUE Program Welcome Sessions get Ukrainian newcomers familiar with the CUE program, various other EMCN programs and supports, and they fill out an application form.
- EMCN Career Counselors book one-on-one meetings to conduct employment assessment and develop a personal service plan for each participant.
- 3. Newcomers can attend workshops.
- 4. EMCN's Employment Placement Specialists connect newcomers with various employers during an active job search until they get a job.
- 5. EMCN hosts job fairs, hiring events and info sessions just for CUE program newcomers.
- 6. EMCN covers cost of safety tickets and safety equipment for Ukrainian newcomers as required.
- 7. EMCN provides ongoing support to help mitigate challenges for newcomers in the workplace. Support may include phone or in-person meetings with the newcomer and/or employer, and ongoing e-services for up to 180 days for Ukrainian newcomers after they have secured employment.

Who Can Access the Program

- Ukrainian Nationals with Temporary Residence status as defined by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC).
- Ukrainians arriving in Canada through the Canada-Ukraine Authorization for Emergency Travel (CUAET) pathway.
- Ukrainians that are 18 years of age or older.
- Ukrainians that are residing in Alberta.
