Community-Based Care for Newcomer Children Program (CBCNC)

Learners in Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada (LINC) classes anywhere in Edmonton may be eligible for childcare at no cost in a licensed daycare or day home for children aged 5 or younger under the Community-Based Care for Newcomer Children (CBCNC) program.

Program Eligibility

Immigration status	Permanent Resident
Children	Pre-school aged children or children in half-day kindergarten
Family Income	Family income according to Alberta Government subsidy guidelines
CLB Level	Canadian Language Benchmark or CLB Level will be assessed. You must qualify for LINC school.
LINC School	Secured a space in a LINC school
Financial Assistance	Require financial assistance in order to attend LINC school

Intake Process

- 1. One-on-One Meeting**
Meet with one of our EMCN counsellors to ensure you meet all eligibility requirements.
- 2. Required Documents**
Confirm all required documents are shared, such as:
 - + LINC school acceptance letter
 - + Permanent Resident card
 - + Birth certificate or healthcare card for each child
 - + Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) Notice of Tax Assessment (latest tax information)
- 3. Daycare Selection**
Assistance in finding a childcare facility close to your home or LINC school.
