Our Audience

This signature event pulls over 600 guests comprising government representatives at all levels, captains of industries, civil society, media, influencers and community members in an avenue that fosters an alignment with immigrants in Edmonton.

Every year, our audience collectively contribute to creating an inspirational and memorable evening enriched with culture, musical performances, intercultural dinner buffet, and awards presentation to most distinguished community members.

Engaging with us on social media platforms, we promote shared stories and amplify community voices and partnerships that enrich Edmonton.

- Our key Social handles; Tiktok, Instagram, LinkedIn, Twitter and Facebook bring in 18k to 20k unique views/Impressions with a 10-12% month to month growth.
- Total followership of socials spread across all platforms : 12,180.
- 66% of followers and engaged audience are from 25 - 44 age group of which 66.9% is women and 33.1% men.
- Content reach is 88% within Canada.

Impact Story

During my marriage, my son and I experienced gender-based and family violence, as well as the affects of living with someone who had alcohol and substance abuse addictions.

In fall of 2015, we legally separated and amidst the overwhelming legal, financial, housing and immigration issues, we also were dealing with police engagement and ongoing psychological trauma. That's when we were connected with free therapeutic and counselling services at EMCN. Once my child and I started with therapeutic services at EMCN, we were also offered extended wraparound supports by EMCN related to immigration, settlement, legal, financial and social supports for our complex case management as well as some other community agency supports available to us.

“With EMCN’s staff, programs and services, my teenage child and myself have found a degree of stability in our lives as we continue to address our ongoing situation. One of the greatest gifts we have received is real-life tools to be more financially independent, knowledge about how to navigate the legal and immigration systems and how to find hope for more joyful and rewarding lives here in Canada.”
