What is the EMCN Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada (LINC) Program?

LINC is a free English language training program for eligible adult learners designed to improve basic and intermediate reading, writing, listening and speaking skills, as well as learn about daily living in Canada and the workplace.

Who is eligible to enroll?

Participants eligible are those that have taken an English placement test with Catholic Social Services Language Assessment, Referral, and Counselling Centre (CSS LARC), and are:

- Adult (18 years old or older);
- Permanent Residents; or those on a valid Ukrainian (CUAET) Work Permit.

Childcare services

- **Free on-site childcare services** may be available to parents enrolled in in-person LINC classes during the day and have a child or children aged 6 months to 5 years old, or
- **Free community-based childcare services** may be available to parents enrolled in online LINC classes and have preschool or younger children.
