Learners in Language Instruction for Newcomers to Canada (LINC) classes anywhere in Edmonton may be eligible for childcare at no cost in a licensed daycare or day home for children aged 5 or younger under the Community-Based Care for Newcomer Children (CBCNC) program. Funded by Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC).

The CBCNC program is also supported by the Newcomer Centre Settlement team for LINC students.

Program Eligibility

Immigration Status	Permanent Resident
Children	Pre-school aged children or children in half-day kindergarten
CLB Level	Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) Level will be assessed. You must qualify for LINC school
LINC School	Secure a spot in a LINC school
Financial Assistance	Require financial assistance to attend LINC school

Intake Process

1. One-on-One Meeting

Meet with one of our Newcomer Centre counsellors to ensure you meet all eligibility requirements.

2. Required Documents

Confirm all required documents are shared.

- + LINC school acceptance letter
- + Permanent Resident card
- + Birth certificate or healthcare card for each child
- + Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) Notice of Assessment (latest tax information)

3. Daycare Selection

Provide assistance in finding a childcare facility close to your home or LINC school.
