Immigrant women often face isolation and the challenges of navigating a new country. IWIN is designed to support women by providing a robust support system that fosters confidence, belonging, and success.

Program Available

- 7-week cohort (3 days/week, in-person or virtual)
- Afternoon sessions
- Weekly drop-in sessions for extra support

Eligibility:

- Identify as a female immigrant
- Have Permanent Resident (PR) status in Canada or be a Refugee Claimant with a positive notice of decision
- Have a Canadian Language Benchmark (CLB) proficiency of at least Level 4 or higher in speaking and listening
- 18 years of age or older
- Reside in Metropolitan Edmonton area.
